Cooper is a media epithet (actual pseudonym: Dan Cooper) used to describe an unidentified man who hijacked a Boeing 727 on November 24, 1971, extorted a US\$200,000 ransom (equivalent to \$1.24 million today.), and parachuted to an unknown fate. He was never seen again, and only \$5,880 of the ransom money has been found. The incident continues to influence popular culture, and has inspired ...
